The data is stored, suitably protected, on a memory stick/computer and/or in a ledger, and may be provided to committee members and other members by email or telephone when it is needed to facilitate the running of the Association and provide the benefits of membership to you.

The Committee intends to maintain a directory of members' contact details as shown above, specifically, Name. Address. Telephone number(s). Email address. This information is available only to Management Committee members or event organisers.

Your details can be removed from our stored records within 28 days of a written request to the Association Secretary or Membership Secretary, or (if appointed) a duly elected Officer. Please contact us if you believe there is a problem with the WNTA handling of your data.

If you do not sign the form, but continue to pay your subscription, we will regard this as acceptance.
